Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council a proposed Resolution accepting the amounts and rates determined by the Montgomery County Budget Commission from tax levies in the City of Centerville. Council concurred that Mr. Kenning pursue a correction in the amount of revenue received from the voted General Bond Retirement Fund.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Agreement with the Combined Health District of Montgomery County providing that 10% of the funds received by the City through the State of Ohio for Liquor Permit Fees be paid to the Health District for prevention and for the treatment and rehabilitation of alcoholics for the year 1985.

Mrs. McLaughlin advised that the terms of Robert Hensley, Stephen Mikula and L. H. Rogero, Jr. will soon expire on the Board of Tax Appeals. They have indicated a desire to serve another term. Council concurred that said reappointments be made.

Mayor Heintz briefly reviewed her recommendation for appointments to Council Committees and Centerville Representatives on various Agencies. Council concurred with said appointments.

Mr. Farquhar reviewed his correspondence concerning the Southmont Realty Matter, 93 West Franklin Street. He reviewed for Council the present status of the law suit filed by Mr. Sarber to recover damages to his property. This matter will become a consideration for the Centerville Property Review Commission.
