Mr. Kenning reviewed the following Bids received for street improvements in the City of Centerville for 1985:


Republic Asphalt Paving Company	\$200,429.25 (asphalt streets)
TdM Construction Company	\$490,225.39 (asphalt and concrete streets, sidewalk and SR 48 widening)
Trojan Asphalt, Inc.	\$390,417.00 (asphalt and concrete streets)
R. E. Holland Excavating, Inc.	\$128,953.03 (sidewalk and SR 48 widening)
TRIASCO	\$231,025.50 (asphalt streets)

Mr. Kenning recommended that the Bid of TdM Construction Company consisting of concrete street repair and resurfacing of asphalt roadways as well as the widening of South Main Street be accepted, limiting quantities and the total cost not to exceed \$395,000.00. He further recommended that the Bid of TdM Construction Company for sidewalk be accepted with limited quantities, total cost not to exceed \$30,000.00.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Contract for the preliminary engineering for the improvement of South Main Street and Spring Valley Road with Lockwood, Jones and Beals in the amount of \$11,952.00. Discussion followed relative to the acceptance of the low and best bids received. Mr. Singer requested that reasons for the selection of Lockwood, Jones and Beals be outlined and placed on file.

Mr. Kenning announced the receipt of the Inheritance Tax - first cut- in the amount of 92,000.00. He also advised that Motor Vehicle Tax, final 1980 distribution has been received amounting to an additional \$28,000.00.

Mr. Samples recommended that David Blum be appointed as a Member of the Zoning Task Force Committee. Council concurred that this matter be added to the Council Meeting Agenda.
