- 3. Architectural Preservation District Replacing the current mercury vapor lights with decorative lantern type fixtures will be explored. The traffic lights at Main and Franklin Streets should become more appropriate for the A-P District.
- 4. Fire Department A joint fire district was discussed, information relative to legal drawbacks is needed. Fire Chief Randall Staley should be invited to a future Meeting of Council to discuss future plans for the Washington Township Fire Department.
- 5. City Planning Commission Attendance will be monitored at Meetings.
- 6. Liquor Control Ordinance (Keg) Proposed revisions were discussed.
- MCD Equipment The Company's formal protest was discussed relative to a Bid being awarded to another supplier. The question arose as to whether the City should have a policy regarding this type protest.
- 8. 911 A 911 Committee has been activated in Montgomery County. If the Plan is formalized, there will be a cost to local governments
- Committee on Bicycling Members are Wanda Molen (Chairman), Barry Ryan, Bill Talbot, Ben Rice and Jeanne Eickman. Mr. Siler will serve as the Council Liaison.
