

Discussed were the Public Hearing dates to be scheduled for the Rezoning Request and the Conditional Use Application submitted for St. Elizabeth Retirement Center, Inc., proposed to be located at Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road and Bigger Road. The Planning Commission has recommended approval of the Rezoning Request and has tabled the Conditional Use until their September 24, 1985 Meeting. The Applicant has requested that both Public Hearings be scheduled for the same date due to their travel requirements. Council concurred that this be done.

Mayor Heintz advised that correspondence has been received from Linclay Corporation requesting that their Conditional Use Application to locate a Rocky Rococo Pan Style Pizza Restaurant in an outlot at the Cross Pointe Centre be withdrawn from the Council Meeting agenda. This item has been set for Public Hearing before Council this date.

Mayor Heintz advised that the Mayors and Managers of Montgomery County has designated October 31, 1985 as Beggars Night. Council concurred that this same date be observed in the City of Centerville, time being between 6:00 and 8:00 P.M.
