By majority vote of Council, Charles Taylor was elected Deputy-Mayor for 1984-1985.

Council discussed a letter of resignation received from Councilman Russell Sweetman. Upon Mr. Stone's acceptance, Council concurred to appoint J. V. Stone to this vacant seat on City Council.


Mrs. McLaughlin advised that those candidates contacted, all accepted to serve as members of the Charter Review Commission. The necessary legislation has been prepared.

Mrs. McLaughlin advised Council that Mrs. Phyllis Brooks and Mr. Robert Perkins do not seek reappointment on the Board of Architectural Review.

Mayor Heintz reviewed her recommendation for appointments to Council Committees, Council Liaison and Centerville's Representation in other areas of Government.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a Resolution to accept amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and to authorize the necessary tax levies to the Montgomery County Auditor, for the City of Centerville.

Mr. Kenning also reviewed a Contract with the Combined General Health District of Montgomery County to provide for a rehabilitation program for alcoholics, cost to the City of Centerville is 10% of funds received by the City from the State of Ohio for liquor permit fees.
