Dorothy Crockett was interviewed for appointment as a Member of the Sister City Committee. Council concurred with said appointment.

Nora Lake, Executive Director of the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission, reviewed for Council MVRPC today and the restructuring, goals and objectives and new directions for the Commission as proposed by the Strategic Planning Committee. She highly recommends the adoption and implementation of this Plan as proposed.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposal for the construction of a bus stop shelter and sidewalk in front of the Chevy Chase Apartment Complex. This is a Community Development project estimated to cost a total of \$33,000.00 with Grant money amounting to \$20,000.00. Council concurred with this proposal provided that the shelter opening face the south, more benches be included inside the shelter and that no name be affixed upon the shelter.

Discussion followed relative to a letter received from Mr. Alan Krohn, 43 Weller Avenue, citing a neighborhood problem existing at 35 Weller Avenue. This matter will be further reviewed by Mr. Kenning and report back to City Council.
