

Mr. Robert Hosfeld was interviewed for appointment to the City Beautiful Commission. He has also submitted an Application for the Sister City Committee and the Planning Commission. Council concurred that Mr. Hosfeld be appointed as a Member of the City Beautiful Commission and that he be considered in the future when a vacancy occurs on the Planning Commission, for this he is better qualified.

Mr. Kenning reviewed proposed amendments to the City Charter as previously requested by City Council during a Work Session Meeting.

Mr. Kenning solicited Council's authorization to extend the current Contract with T.d.M. Construction Company in order to provide improvements to South Main Street between Sheehan Road and Marco Lane in the City of Centerville. The estimated extension needed is \$12,070.00. Council concurred with this proposal.

Mr. Kenning advised that the Dayton Power and Light Company has requested that their Conditional Use Request to provide a heliport on Clyo Road be withdrawn.
