Mr. Kenning reviewed a request submitted by Attorney Barry Mancz for the extension of the Subdivider's Agreement executed on Thomas Paine Settlement Number Three-Clyo Road, for a term of six months: from December 10, 1984 to June 10, 1985. This is a duplication of previous extensions granted by City Council.


Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council a proposed Resolution to execute the ICMA Retirement Trust and to designate the City Manager as the coordinator for this program.

Mr. Kenning briefly reviewed Budget related items on the Council Meeting agenda following this Work Session.

Mr. Kenning reviewed the Bids received for the purchase of a refuse collection truck for the City of Centerville. He recommended the acceptance of the Bid submitted by Buckeye Refuse Equipment Company in the amount of \$91,661.40. This Bidder will submit a Performance Bond on delivery.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Resolution to provide for Workers' Compensation coverage for volunteer workers: volunteers participating in the City's organized volunteer program, and volunteer members of City Boards and Commissions. The cost of this program to the City is \$200.00 annually. Council concurred that this item be added to the Council Meeting agenda following this Work Session.

Mayor Heintz reviewed procedural changes to be instituted in the Council Meeting, changes provided for by recent Charter changes.
