Mrs. McLaughlin advised that the term of Michael Pekarek will soon expire as a Member of the Board of Architectural Review, however he is interested in serving another term. Council concurred that Mr. Pekarek be appointed to serve another term on said Board. Necessary legislation will be added to the agenda for the Council Meeting to follow.

Mayor Stone reviewed a request of Max Gutmann that a Proclamation be issued recognizing Elder-Beerman's 100th Anniversary and their existence in the City of Centerville since 1968. Council concurred that said Proclamation be issued.

Mr. Bormet briefly reviewed a Resolution and an Ordinance necessary for the issuance of Notes and Bonds in order to pay for the telephone and paging systems for the City of Centerville. Various Members of Council expressed concern with this procedure, they were unaware that money would be borrowed for this purpose. Mr. Sweetman recommended that a page be added to the Budget document, detailing items included which will require the City to borrow money for purchase.

Due to the lack of alternative information relative to the purchase of an asphalt paver, Council concurred that this matter be delayed for consideration during a future Meeting.
