

Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council a revised Site Plan for Hartford House, proposed to be located at 179 North Main Street, behind the Main Auto Parts Building in the Architectural Preservation District. This revised Plan now includes all conditions of Council discussed during a previous Work Session Meeting, except that the barrier curbs are designated as 12 inches underground and 6 inches above ground.

Mr. Kenning advised that a Resolution is necessary to accept another Bid for the mowing of City Property during the summer months. One of the successful Bidders has withdrawn his Bid. This Resolution has been placed on the agenda for the Council Meeting to follow.

Council discussed the possibility of establishing a summer meeting schedule. Council concurred that beginning May 16, 1983 and continuing through August, 1983, Work Sessions will be held on the second Monday of each month and Council Meetings on the third Monday of each month. Thus affording ample time to consider items coming to Council from the Planning Commission. Other Meetings may be held if necessary.
