Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council a Supplemental Retirement Plan for City employees. Mr. Kenning explained that under this plan, City employees who retire with a minimum of five years service and 50 days accrued sick leave would be eligible for \$250 per year of service, with department heads receiving \$500 per year of service.

Discussion of the plan followed, with the majority of Council concurring that this plan be adopted, but there be no distinction for department heads, resulting in all eligible employees receiving \$250 per year of service.

Mr. Brian Forschner, representing St. Leonard's Center, discussed the activities that are currently underway at the Center. The Center has begun to accept residents, with approximately 15-20 residing there at this time.

Mr. Forschner discussed with Council St. Leonard's Emergency Shelter Program. Mr. Forschner stated that the Board decided to terminate the program, and that the shelter was closed three weeks ago. Mayor Stone advised Mr. Forschner that Council would like to be consulted if the Board is inclined to renew the Emergency Shelter Program.

Mr. Kenning reviewed the proposed outdoor sales ordinance. Mr. Kenning noted that the impetus for this proposal was the perception that a number of businesses encounter difficulties in complying with the City's present policies. The majority of Council concurred that this ordinance be scheduled for public hearing.

Mr. Kenning reviewed the proposal of Tom Stolz to place a shelter in Leonard Stubbs Park. Council concurred with Mr. Stolz proposal.

Mr. Kenning reviewed the request of MVRPC for \$100 from the City. Council concurred that the City provide the money to MVRPC.
