Mr. Kenning advised that Inheritance Tax for 1983 to the City of Centerville will be approximately \$68,000.00; \$36,000.00 was estimated.

Mr. Kenning reviewed the decision rendered by the Centerville-Washington Township Chamber of Commerce not to relocate in the Asahel Wright House; the Chamber will vacate their present office in the South Suburban Annex building on or before October 31, 1983. Mr. Kenning will pursue the rental of this office space.



Mr. Kenning reminded City Council that the Board of Architectural Review and the Planning Commission both recommended that the proposed Outdoor Sales and Display Ordinance not be passed.

City Council concurred that a conversion plan be reviewed relative to insurance coverage when an employee terminates his/her employment with the City of Centerville. This will be considered during a future Council Work Session Meeting.
