Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council a proposed Cooperative Agreement between South of Dayton Communities to provide for the registration of bonded debt obligations by a private contractor. This registration is required because of the Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act of 1982. Council concurred that the City Manager be authorized to enter into such an Agreement.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a letter received from MVRPC Executive Director Nora Lake concerning the designation of the agency to perform Intergovernmental Review Functions (A-95 Review). Council concurred that a letter be sent to the Montgomery County Commissioners endorsing the continuation of MVRPC as that agency.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Resolution alerting the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation of a potential dangerous situation in the City of Centerville and asking that necessary steps be taken to alleviate the problem; said potential situation resulting from the culverts designed for construction under I-675. Council concurred that said Resolution be passed and sent to the Department of Transportation along with a letter outlining the City's concerns. Letters will also be sent to Robert Corbin and Tom Fries.
