Council discussed renaming some park land in Centerville in memory of deceased Council Member Leonard Stubbs. Council concurred to proceed with legislation to actuate this at the appropriate time, perhaps on his birthday.

Mr. Kenning advised that the Court of Appeals has dismissed the Bethany Lutheran Annexation Case, thus necessary action can proceed at the next Council Meeting.

Mr. Kenning advised that the State of Ohio, Elections Commission has reviewed Centerville's case and has found that Centerville violated the Elections law without willful intent.

Mr. Robert Petrokas, representing the Miami Valley Combined General Health District, was present to review for Council their proposed Contract for Centerville for 1982. He reviewed Contract prices from 1977 through 1982 and outlined services rendered in the City of Centerville. Discussion followed relative to the formation of the Board of Health and the fact that Centerville wants representation on this Board. Council will further discuss the proposed Contract for Centerville for the year 1982 at a future Council Work Session Meeting.

Mr. Alan Schwab, City Planner, reviewed for Council a proposed new telephone system for the Centerville Municipal Building. Council concurred that this proposal should be reviewed by the Community Fiscal Analysis Committee for study and review.
