## CENTERVILLE CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION MEETING APRIL 26, 1982

Mr. Bruce Zeigler, representing the Chamber of Commerce, reviewed for Council, plans for the Americana Festival to be held Monday, July 5, 1982, which is the legal holiday for the 4th of July. They are asking for assistance in traffic control and pedestrian traffic. Depending upon good weather conditions, the Committee expects 12 to 15 thousand people in attendance for the Festival. Their plans are to close Main and Franklin between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.. They ask that the streets be cleaned by the City of Centerville and Washington Township.

Following an interview with Anne Elliott Rausch, Council concurred that she be appointed as a member of the City Beautiful Commission. Necessary legislation will be prepared.

Council concurred that additional applicants be solicited for appointment on the Board of Architectural Review. Currently there is one vacancy on the Board.

Council reviewed a proposed Facility Use Policy for use of the Community Room by various organizations. Council concurred that assignments be made on a first come, first serve basis, that a charge of \$10.00 be required from non-resident groups and that the use be limited to non-profit organizations. The remainder of the proposed Facility Use Policy is adequate.

Amendments to the organization and charge of Boards and Commissions will be discussed during a future Council Work Session.

Council discussed the single line telephone system proposed for the Municipal Building. Mr. Kenning advised that through investigation into other similar systems, it was found that Management likes the system, staff does not like it. Mr. Sweetman defined problems experienced by other users. Mr. Sweetman also identified the need for an intercom system throughout the Building. Council concurred that specifications be prepared to go to bid for the proposed system, that the specifications be reviewed by the C-FACTs Committee and then advertised. An Intercom will be included in the specifications, as an alternate.

The majority of Council concurred that the Health District Contract be placed on the agenda for the next Council Meeting.
