Mr. Schwab reviewed the Site Plan Amendment proposed for the Woodbourne Library located at 6060 Far Hills Avenue in the City of Centerville. Proposed is the addition of 15 parking spaces to the existing parking area. The pavement would be extended to the south of the existing parking area providing 6 spaces on each side (east and west) and 3 spaces to the end (south). The Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval of this Site Plan Amendment as submitted.

Mr. Kenning advised that representatives from other Municipalities have met with the Dayton Power and Light Company to review 1983 contract proposals. The following alternatives surfaced: 1. DP&L will provide cost data for review, 2. DP&L would prefer to get out of the street light business and 3. DP&L proposes to stop furnishing additional street lights in 1983. Mr. Kenning will continue to update Council concerning this matter.

Upon question of Mr. Kenning, Council set the next Council Outreach Meeting for Tuesday, August 24 at 7:30 A.M. at Denny's Restaurant on Far Hills Avenue.

Mr. Kenning advised that he has been pursuing the joint purchase of road planting equipment with eight other Cities Council concurred to explore the idea of joint purchase and that the needs of the City be outlined.
