Council interviewed Linda Neufeld, applicant for appointment on the Community Fiscal Analysis Committee. Council concurred that this appointment be added to the Council Meeting agenda, to follow.

Mr. Bettcher explained for Council a recommendation by the City Manager that the Waste Collection Fee be increased by \$.69 in order to provide for the projected increase in the tipping fee charged by Montgomery County. Mrs. Heintz suggested that the increase reflect an even amount (\$18.00 to \$20.00 per three month period) and that this increase not take effect until January 1, 1983. Mr. Bormet reviewed the procedure followed for Waste Collection billing. Mr. Siler suggested that the fee be increased by \$.75 per month for a total increase of \$2.25 per three month period. Council concurred with this suggestion.

As suggested by City Staff, Council concurred that the Arts Commission Fund be abolished and that said funds be transferred to the General Fund.

Mayor Stone suggested and City Council concurred to set the item, Bigger Road Improvement, for discussion during a Council Work Session Meeting; and that Fire Chief Randall Staley be present for this Meeting. The major question being whether fire protection would be endangered due to poor access from the Fire Station Number Four on Thomas Paine Parkway.

The Site Plan Amendment submitted for Bob Ross Buick, Inc. was briefly discussed by Council. Proposed is to asphalt pave the gravel area and to construct a temporary sales building on the site for a period of one to two years. No objections were offered by Council.
