
Members of the Centerville-Washington Township Task Force for Senior Citizens: Cynthia Klinck, Cecilia Blasi and Staley Ioanus were present at this Meeting to review for Council their proposal for funding of a Senior Citizens Center. They have acquired space at St. Leonards free of charge until the end of 1982. They propose to continue renting space at St. Leonards through 1983. The proposal solicits City's funding in the amount of \$1,500.00 through 1982 and \$13,600.00 for 1983. Council concurred with this expenditure.

Chief Randolph reviewed for Council a Police Report prepared several months previous. He outlined responsibilities of the Police Officers and procedures of the Department. He explained Centerville's ranking in various aspects vs. other Municipalities of comparable size. He reviewed goals and objectives of the Centerville Police Department. Chief Randolph recommended certain growths in the Department over the next several years.


Mr. James Wasson advised that the Safety Committee of C-FACS reviewed the Report and offered no complaints with the Police Department.

Discussion followed relative to the stepping up of neighborhood watch programs to deter crime in neighborhoods.

Mrs. McLaughlin advised that Lester Stauske has indicated a desire to serve another term as a Member of the Personnel Appeals Board. Council concurred that the necessary legislation be prepared to make this reappointment.
