Council concurred to reappoint Charles Brown as a Member of the Personnel Appeals Board. The necessary legislation was prepared for the Council Meeting to follow.

Mayor Stone advised that Applicants for the vacancy on City Council will be interviewed Monday, March 9, 1981 beginning at 7:45 P.M. A Special Council Meeting will follow to finalize the appointment.

Mr. Kenning reviewed four proposed Contracts with the Montgomery County Combined General Health District for the year 1981. Mr. Kenning had previously recommended not funding the staff development and in-service training program and the Free Clinic. Mrs. Lake suggested funding these two programs just 50% the amount requested by the Health District. Mr. Sweetman requested that the City Staff review the possibility of establishing a Health Department within the City of Centerville for the year 1982. Council concurred to sign all four Contracts for 1981 but to reduce the amount requested by 50% for the in-service training program and the Free Clinic.

Mrs. Heintz reviewed a Public Hearing she attended in Columbus concerning the Merger Bill.
