Upon question of Mr. Sweetman, Mr. Kenning will present statistics on signage at Joes is a Fish House.

Mr. Sweetman questioned a cut in the median strip on the newly constructed Clyo Road in front of the Centerville Mill. The majority of Council concurred that the project be stopped pending further investigation.
