Mr. Kenning reviewed the Public Hearing held on Revenue Sharing Funds for fiscal year 1982. The Hearing was held in the Council Chambers at 6:30 P.M. on Tuesday, May 5, 1981. There was no one from the public in attendance at the Meeting. Funds will be utilized in the same manner as in 1981. We estimate receiving approximately \$65,000.00.

Mr. Kenning advised that the City's grant request for a litter control and recycling program has been received and accepted for consideration.

City Council reviewed a proposed amendment to the Sign Ordinance. Mr. Kenning highlighted certain areas of change. Discussion followed concerning the control of political signs. The majority of Council concurred that a cash amount of \$100.00 be deposited with the City to insure removal of the signs. The proposed Ordinance will be directed to the Centerville Chamber of Commerce to receive input.

Recommendations of the C-Facs Committee were discussed by Council. Mayor Stone will respond to Chairman George Chamberlain with positive feedback. Mayor Stone, Deputy-Mayor Nora Lake, the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the C-Facs Committee will meet to discuss future endeavors of the Committee.

Mayor Stone reviewed a Meeting he had with Washington Township Trustee Walter Buchanan a few weeks previous. Council briefly discussed the future for the City of Centerville.
