Following discussion, Council concurred that Ordinances containing various fee revisions be discussed during a Council Work Session Meeting prior to being set for Public Hearing.

Mr. Minner reviewed a proposed space rental Agreement between the City of Centerville and the Heritage United Presbyterian Church for office space on the second floor of the South Suburban Annex Building. Council concurred that the City Staff compile cost comparison figures, review the proposal against other possibilities and bring the matter to a future Council Work Session for further discussion.

Council concurred that legislation be considered during the Council Meeting to follow, to appoint Mr. Ringwall, Mr. Claypool, Mr. John Corwin and Mr. Stephen Mikula to this Committee. Council also concurred that Membership on this Committee be increased to 22 due to a recent precinct split in Centerville.
