The future for the Centerville Community was discussed briefly by Council.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a letter received from the Committee for Continued Health Services soliciting the City's endorsement of the Combined General Health District of Montgomery County levy, known as issue 3 in the November 3, 1981 election. Council concurred that "Council as a whole" not take a position on this issue, this is in accordance with Council's policy over previous years.

Council concurred that Ordinance Number 12-81, An Ordinance Amending Chapter 191 Of The Centerville Municipal Code To Require The Filing Of Income Tax Returns By Persons Not Required To Pay Any Tax Because Of A Tax Credit For Taxes Paid To Other Municipalities (Mandatory Filing) be placed back on the Council Meeting agenda for consideration.

Mr. Kenning reviewed his analysis of the current telephone system in the Municipal Building. He recommended going to bid for acquisition of a new telephone system. Council concurred with this recommendation.

Council reviewed a draft of a general Ordinance for all City Boards and Commissions; various changes were suggested. The draft will be revised containing these changes and brought back for Council's further consideration at a Work Session Meeting.

Council discussed legislation to restrict the parking of vehicles in residential areas. Council concurred to further discuss this matter with pictorial exhibits for consideration.

Mrs. Heintz solicited Council's reaction to TCC's proposal to transfer \$100,000.00 from the Van Acquisition Fund to Operation Ride Share. Council concurred that this revenue be utilized for a higher priority project.
