Mr. Kenning advised that the three year term of Richard Rice as a Member of the Personnel Appeals Board is due to expire soon. Council concurred to reappoint Mr. Rice to another term on said Board.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Agreement between the City of Centerville and Montgomery County for the continuation of the Community Block Grant Program under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1977. Council concurred to proceed with legislation to authorize this Agreement.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Agreement with the Montgomery County Combined General Health District for services relating to the treatment and rehabilitation of alcoholics for the City of Centerville. The agreement provides for the payment of 10% of the City's Liquor Permit Fees to the Health District for said service. Council concurred with this proposal.

Council reviewed the Site Plan Amendment proposed for the McIntire Building, located at 60 West Franklin Street in the City of Centerville. Recommendations of the Board of Architectural Review and the City Planning Commission were outlined.


Mr. Kenning announced the receipt of a Temporary Injunction filed to enjoin the Clerk of Council from presenting the annexation application of Bethany Lutheran Village to City Council.

Mr. Kenning briefed Council on a complaint filed by Mr. Chester Conn with the Ohio Elections Commission in reference to the Income Tax Brochure prepared by the City of Centerville prior to the August 4, 1981 election. Mr. Kenning will appear on behalf of the City of Centerville at the Public Hearing before the Ohio Elections Commission on November 12, 1981.
