One, two and three year terms were designated for appointees to the Community Fiscal Analysis Committee. George Chamberlain was designated as Chairman.

Council concurred that Elmer Tate, Marian Simmons and Dallas Horvath be reappointed as members of the City Planning Commission.

Mr. Kenning and Service Director Richard Bishop reviewed bids received for the purchase of a waste packer truck. Past experience with Bode-Finn was outlined for City Council.

Mr. Kenning reviewed an amendment to the Personnel Ordinance to bring former DPSU employees into the Ordinance. The amendment also includes a provision for Mayor and Council to join the City's Hospitalization Plan upon reimbursement. If this Emergency Ordinance is passed as prepared, compensation is retroactive to March 24, 1980.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a case filed with PUCO concerning the Dayton Power and Light Company's new proposed rates and regulations governing street lighting. Up-front monies are needed to argue the unreasonableness of the rules. Mr. Sweetman suggested utilizing legal service from MVRPC if possible. Mr. Stone suggested that a lump sum be considered rather than a per capita share. Council concurred that personnel and citizen effort be offered rather than expenditures of funds.

The majority of Council concurred that the Architectural Preservation District Ordinance be forwarded to the City Planning Commission as prepared.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Ordinance to tighten provisions concerning building and structural nuisances in the City of Centerville.
