Mr. Kenning reviewed the 1980 Audit Report and explained citations, the Report contained no findings, no payments contrary to statute and no adjustments required.



Council concurred that Mr. R. Paul Perkins be invited to attend the next Council Work Session to discuss the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra coming to Centerville in 1981. They have cancelled the 1980-81 Area Artist Series due to a conflict in dates.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a Resolution to reallocate Income Tax Receipts among the General Fund, Capital Improvements Fund and Debt Retirement Fund for 1980.

Mr. Stubbs announced Budget review by the Council Finance Committee to be held Saturday, November 8, 1980, Saturday, November 15, 1980 and Saturday, November 22, 1980 to begin at 8:45 A.M. in the Council Chambers.
