Arts Commission Applicant Jane Cluett was interviewed by City Council. Legislation for this appointment was an agenda item for the Council Meeting to follow.

Mr. Minner reviewed the Bids received for the purchase of 2 passenger sedans and 2 police vehicles for the City of Centerville. The City Staff recommended that the Bid for 2 passenger sedans be accepted while the Bid for two police vehicles be readvertised.

Mr. Minner briefly reviewed the Proposal by Kraft-Shaw-Meiss and Associates for the final engineering services and the preparation of contract plans for the reconstruction and widening of Bigger Road. This is a Federally funded project with joint participation by the City of Centerville and the City of Kettering. The City's share amounts to approximately \$8,900.00. Necessary funds are available and have been budgeted.

Mr. Minner reviewed the Proposal of Lockwood, Jones and Beals for the East Whipp Road Preliminary Development Phase. This project includes a study for the widening and straightening of East Whipp Road. This is a Federally funded project with the City of Centerville and Washington Township participating. The City's share is \$22,277.00.
