Council briefly discussed an employee discount for services and materials at the Family Optical Center in Centerville. Mayor Green pointed out possible conflicts in the future with this type program. Other Councilmembers offered their concern also. It was concurred that the program would be stopped.

Council concurred not to waive fees required in the construction of the new Library and Stadium at the High School.

Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council a request from Joes is a Fish House for the issuance of Industrial Revenue Bonds for the financing of this proposed Restaurant. This matter will be discussed during a future Council Work Session Meeting scheduled prior to the Public Hearing on the Ordinance necessary for same.

Council concurred that legislation be prepared to effectuate the street name change in Hidden Hills, requested by property owners in the subdivision.

Mr. Kenning reviewed bids received for the purchase of one backhoe/front hoader. Mr. Kenning recommended that the Bid of New Carlisle Tractor be accepted for a Case 580 backhoe, based upon the fact that this was the low bid and the closest to the amount budgeted. Mr. Sweetman favored the purchase of a John Deere rather than a Case.

Mr. Kenning advised that the new Kroger store will open April 1. Berming and the traffic signal installation will be completed soon. The signal should be in operation by April 15. Mr. Sweetman encouraged other improvements be completed (mounding and landscaping) by June 15.
