The Meeting was called for Council to meet with Board of Architectural Review Members to explain to them action taken on May 21 concerning the statues in front of the Antonio's Restaurant. During the Meeting Council expressed their appreciation to the BAR Members for their efforts in the AP District. The BAR Members were asked to reconsider their decision to resign. Emphasis was placed upon the lack of communications between the Council and BAR during consideration of this issue. The following suggestions were made for the future:

- 1. Better communications between Council, the BAR and the Business Community.
- 2. Consideration should be given to increasing the Board to seven Members, one being a representative from the Business Community.
- 3. Perhaps some guidelines should be established between the Council and BAR to achieve what is intended for the AP District.

Mrs. Lake suggested that a letter be sent from Mayor Green to all Members of the BAR asking them to reconsider their resignation.

Discussed in conjunction with this matter was the amendment to the AP District Ordinance. It was concurred that this Ordinance be considered for Public Hearing at the next Council Meeting. Considered in conjunction with this will be an amendment to the Sign Ordinance and increasing the Membership of the Board to seven.
