Mr. Kenning advised that Centerville's Local Government Fund appeal should be resolved the week of August 6, 1979. Council concurred with the proposed settlement regarding the formula for distribution of future allocations.

Mr. Kenning advised that the members in the Six City Miami Valley Cable Council have been selected as the recipients of the Management Innovation Award presented by the International City Management Association.

Copies of the Budget Opinion Survey were distributed to Council for review. The survey was mailed to 800 households, 15% responded as of July 30, 1979.

Council discussed the Architectural Preservation District in the center of town and amendments to the present Ordinance (what the initial intent was and what has developed). Mayor Green will draft a letter to the Board of Architectural Review Members in answer to their recent requests.
