Mr. Stubbs reported on the Finance Committee Meeting held August 9, 1979. Discussion followed concerning whether to or not place a 1 mil police levy on the November, 1979 ballot.

Mr. Kenning reviewed his recommendation concerning Bids received for the repair and resurfacing of various streets in the City of Centerville.

Mr. Kenning reviewed the status of the railroad right-of-way. The right-of-way is for sale at \$5,000.00 per acre; the City's purchase of this right-of-way would give access control to Clyo Road and would place access for the DART System in public domain. Council concurred that the right-of-way behind the City's Garage be purchased not to exceed \$5,000.00 per acre.

Three designs were reviewed for the Clyo Road improvement. Council concurred that the City continue with the original concept.
