A draft of a proposed ethics ordinance, as prepared and submitted by the Legislative Committee, was distributed. Upon a review of the ordinance, the following change was concurred to by those present: The first sentence of Section I (c) should read "No public official shall represent or appear in behalf of private interest other than his own <u>personal residential interest</u> in any matter pending before any element of the City Government" (underlined words indicate addition). This item was to be placed on the following meeting's agenda.

A resolution proposed by the Citizens for Cooperative and Responsive Government was discussed. This resolution would jointly, with the Washington Township Trustees, appoint a Community Task Force Steering Committee to investigate one form of government for the City and the Township. Council concurred on the placing of this item on the next regular meeting agenda.

The last item discussed was the coordination of appointments for the BAR to coincide with the passage of a new ordinance which will expand the Board by two members. Council agreed to one appointment being placed on the next meeting's agenda but stated that further consideration was preferred before making a second selection.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was adjourned at 8:50 P.M.
