Mr. William Ahern, from the Centerville Chamber of Commerce, requested that Main and Franklin Streets be closed between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM, Saturday, July 1, 1978, during the July 4th Annual Celebration and Fea Market. Discussion followed concerning the overtime costs for Patrolmen and how this expenditure could be paid. The Chamber will discuss this further with the Washington Township Trustees and the County Sheriff's Office to solicit assistance, both financial and manpower. This item will be further discussed during the next Council Work Session Meetning.

Mr. Kenning announced the Public Hearing scheduled concerning Federal Revenue Sharing Funds for 1979, scheduled for Wednesday, May 17, 1978 at 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers.

Mr. Kenning advised that the 1978 Resurfacing Program will be let for bids during this week. The Project is estimated to cost approximately \$70,000.00, Bond Levy Money.

Mr. Kenning reviewed the improvement experiments to be done on streets in the Black Oak South Subdivision. He recommended accepting the Bid from Carey Paving Company, Inc. for these improvements.

Mr. Kenning advised that on May 22, 1978 Montgomery County will consider taking over the three mile jurisdiction. A Resolution has been proposed for consideration by the County Commissioners.

Mr. Kenning briefly reviewed the North Main Street Improvement Project, that portion between Whipp Road and Loop Road.
