Mr. Reynolds reviewed for Council the possible extension of Fireside Drive to provide public access parallel to State Route 48, behind Hunter Savings and the proposed Library facility. Mrs. Lake suggested that the City solicit a 40 foot easement behind the Library and that the road construction and tile be funded through special funds when needed.

Mr. Kenning reviewed the Contract proposed between the City of Centerville and the Montgomery County Public Defender Commission for the year 1979. This would provide for legal assistance and representation to indigent defendants charged with violations of City Ordinances. The City is required under State Law to provide this service. Council concurred that necessary legislation be considered during the Council Meeting to follow.

Council concurred that Mr. John Spoor be appointed to another term om the Sister City Committee for the City of Centerville.

Mr. Kenning suggested that the Township Sidewalk Policy be referred to the City Planning Commission for their review and comment.

Council concurred that the Council Finance Committee meet with the Dayton Power and Light Company to discuss their request for two easements across City Property.
