Mr. Schab reviewed improvements proposed to be made to the drainage swale located in Black Oak Forest, Section Two. Discussion followed as to whether trees would be planted along the boulevard and if so by whom; the erection of a fence between the concrete and soil along the swale and what height the fence should be; and whether the crown vetch could be planted, not seeded. Residents in attendance believed seeding of the crown vetch would be impractical. Mr. Case stated that he did not believe that the trees along the boulevard were included on the Plan as previously approved by residents in Black Oak Forest. Mr. Sweetman offered concern with an erosion problem during construction and pointed out deficiencies in the erection of the fence (poles should be cedar and should be creosoted). It was suggested that a 24" fence instead of 36" be installed along the swale and Mr. Case agreed to this installation. The City agreed to plant trees along the boulevard when funds are available. Mr. Schab will work out a final agreement with Mr. Case, representing Southwestern Reserve Company.
