Mayor Green explained Council's recent decision concerning Parks and Recreation by the City of Centerville. He recognized progress made by the Centerville-Washington Park District in the field of recreation during the past year. Mayor Green advised that the City would be interested in deeding to the Centerville-Washington Park District Elizabeth Hoy Park and Forest Walk Park and would like to sell Benjamin Archer Park to the Park District for the amount of money the City has in the Park land. However, the City would like projects begun continued in Archer Park (fitness trail). Mr. Taylor advised that the Park Board sees no problem in getting more involved in park and recreation activities but they have concerns with the purchase of Archer Park. This park does not lend itself to use as a nature park or a park with active sports which the Park Board is accustomed to establishing. Mr. Kenning suggested that a Committee composed of one Councilmember, one Park Board Member, and one staff member from both the City and the Park District meet and work out the details.
