This Meeting was called to discuss the possibility of removing the Lyons Drive extension from the Bond Levy proposal. Removal was considered based upon the fact that the Lyons Drive extension is not a major overall Community thoroughfare improvement. It was made known that if this issue is dropped from the Bond Issue package, at some time in the future this improvement must be made or some other solution to the problem in that area must be made through some other method of funding.

Various suggestions were made. Mr. McQueeney suggested that perhaps Lyons Drive should be continued to the road entering the Activity Center with the intent to eventually connect into State Route 48. He also suggested that Bradstreet Road continue to the Activity Center with the intent that sometime in the future Lyons Drive be extended to connect.

Mr. Thomas Schaefer, 130 Terrace Villa Drive, outlined concerns of residents in the Terrace Villa Plat. He suggested that consideration be given to making Ridgeway Road exit only from the Plat.

Mayor Green suggested that if Lyons Drive is dropped from the Bond Levy, additional study be given to its extension before a firm decision is made.

Council concurred that the extension of Lyons Drive be dropped from the Bond Issue and that moneys for this purpose be used for other projects or to meet inflation costs on the other projects included in the package.

The Meeting was adjourned.
