Mr. Kenning reviewed Chapter 707 of the Municipal Code with Council. After some discussion, Council agreed Code Section 707 should be repealed. Mr. Kenning also reviewed proposed changes to Chapter 333 of the Municipal Code, which are based upon a request by Judge Berger.

Council then reviewed the Energy Conservation Ordinance with Messrs. Sheeley, Gregg, and Mauer. After a good deal of discussion, the consensus was that thermal break windows ought not be required, but that the remainder of the ordinance should be reviewed when the Home Builders Association have their new recommendation prepared.

The Special Committee then distributed copies of their recommended statement. A lengthy discussion ensued. It was the consensus of the members present that the statement be reworded, and, that the Mayor attempt to establish a meeting with the Trustees on July 11.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:07 P.M.
