Mr. Kenning reviewed the one bid received for the proposed improvement to be made to Ambridge Road and Rolling Oak Drive. Discussion followed as to whether to accept this bid or rebid for the job to be completed in 1978. Mr. Schab pointed out the fact that the Finke Construction Company will complete the job this year or next spring (depending on the weather) at the bid price, if this bid is accepted. Mr. Singer expressed concern with the esthetics of repairing concrete streets with asphalt. Mr. Schab reviewed the advantages of asphalt vs concrete. Mr. Kenning and Mr. Schab recommended that Council accept this lone bid from the Finke Construction Company. The necessary legislation to be considered during the Council Meeting to follow.

As recommended by Mr. Kenning, Council concurred that Centerville pay to Montgomery County the residential waste disposal charge as previously calculated through April, 1976, and that Mr. Kenning continue with negotiations to pay Centerville's portion for the first half of 1977.
