A nomination was made to appoint J. V. Stone, Deputy-Mayor; Council concurred with said appointment.

Council agreed to leave seating arrangement same at the Council table.

Mr. Kenning recommended that he be replaced by Garth Reynolds as Alternate for Charles McQueeney on the TCC and also on the Technical Advisory Committee.

Mr. Kenning outlined the necessity for a Resolution authorizing and directing the City Manager to enter into an Agreement with the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County, Ohio in projects under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.

Council concurred to retain the present Council Committees to complete one year. Mayor Green proposed a Special Committee - Future Resources Planning Committee, to explore various means of additional revenue, including annexation. Mrs. Lake suggested that if such a Committee is formed it should include the Chairman of the Finance Committee as a Member.

A Council Work Session was set for Saturday, January 10, 1976 to begin at 8:30 A.M. in the Conference Room in the Municipal Facility on South Suburban Road. Items to be discussed will include Financial Resources.

Mr. Stubbs proposed a Meeting with the Police Auxiliary to discuss a proposed amendment to the Ordinance which created the organization as soon as such a Meeting can be established.

As requested by Mayor Green, Mr. Kenning will arrange for a joint Meeting between the Centerville Planning Commission and City Council.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned.
