Mayor Green explained a proposed Special Council Committee to review various ways to bring additional revenue to the City, including annexation. The Committee would be entitled Future Resource Planning Committee and would be composed of Leonard Stubbs, Ralph Spencer and Charles McQueeney.

Mayor Green reviewed his 1/2% earnings tax proposal to be earmarked for Waste Collection and Capital Improvements.

The following four methods of providing additional revenue to the City were discussed:

Additional Income Tax.
Earnings Tax
Property Tax (Police Levy)
Bonding

Council also discussed the possibility of a Property Tax increase for trade of Waste Collection charges.

Other items discussed during the Work Session were a proposal by Mr. Sweetman to investigate Waste Collection by private haulers and annexation.

Council concurred that a Public Hearing be held on the second Monday in February to solicit Community Leaders' comments concerning proposed methods to obtain revenue needed by the City.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned.
