Mr. Kenning advised Council that the City has been given the opportunity to acquire law books from a retired Attorney's Library. These books could be used when the City Law Library is developed. Mayor Green referred this matter to the Legal Council Committee for their recommendation to Council.

Mr. Kenning briefed Council on a letter he received from the Centerville-Washington Township Chamber of Commerce asking for Council's support of their Yule Season proposal to purchase several pole-mounted decorations and two streamer signs to be placed over North and South Main Street. Mr. Kenning sees no problem in the City providing manpower and storage as needed. Mayor Green suggested that this be coordinated with the City Beautiful Commission.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Resolution for the City to enter into an Agreement with the Ralph L. Woolpert Company for engineering services in connection with the extension of Clio Road. Three engineering firms were interviewed, fees ranging from \$60,000 to \$75,000. Mr. Kenning and Mr. Schab recommended accepting the services of the Woolpert Company as they were the low bidder and have experience in this field; they are a local firm and can move immediately. Mr. Sweetman and Mr. Spencer expressed concern with the fact that perhaps Woolpert is too involved in the Community. Council concurred that this matter be delayed until the next Council Work Session at which time Mr. Schab will be present for discussion.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned.
