Mr. Preston Dawes, Director of South Montgomery County Youth Services Bureau outlined for Council their primary goals and objectives for 1976. Communities now being served are Centerville, Kettering, Miamisburg, Miami Township, Moraine and West Carrollton. The Bureau's goal is to provide direct services: individual counseling, family counseling and related services. Their objectives are: 1. Establish a South Montgomery County Youth Services Agency, 2. Receive approximately 800 requests for services from various entities, 3. Provide service for 400 youth, 4. Establish method to retain and retrieve data so that Bureau can be evaluated by various Municipal Councils. Mr. Dawes introduced Marianne DaSilva, counselor for the Centerville area, who outlined her services in the Community during the past several months. Mayor Green suggested that before the Teen Center becomes a permanent operation of the City, Miss DaSilva give her opinion and observation of the Center. Miss DaSilva asked for Council's input from time to time.

City Engineer Karl Schab explained to Council why the three firms were chosen to submit proposals for the engineering of the extension of Clio Road. He believes that a large firm is necessary for continuous progress; the Woolpert Company would be adequate and could coordinate this project with other improvements being undertaken in the area. The Woolpert Company has past experience in this field and has qualified engineers on the staff. Mr. Sweetman and Mr. Spencer expressed their concern with a possible conflict of interest: the Woolpert Company represents the property owners upon whose land the roadway will be constructed and did, in fact, carry the petition for assessment proceedings. Mrs. Lake sees their background as a service to Centerville. Mayor Green believes the selection of the Woolpert Company would be good considering the fact that their clients will be footing the bill.


Mr. Schab reviewed the engineering study for the improvement to old Clio Road.
