The Meeting held February 9, 1976 with Citizens to review additional revenue needed by the City was discussed, this matter will be placed on the February 23, 1976 Work Session agenda for a decision.

A letter received from the Board of Montgomery County Commissioners concerning the construction of a water treatment system to improve the quality of water in the Greater Moraine Water District was discussed. This letter does not reflect the conclusion reached by Mayor Green and the City Manager during the meeting of Mayors and Managers at which this item was discussed. Mayor Green suggested that a letter be sent to the County Commissioners advising them of this and informing them that Centerville wishes to consider this matter further before making a commitment.

Mayor Green advised that the term of Shirley Heintz as a Member of the Park and Recreation Board has expired, however, she is desirous of serving another term if Council makes this determination. Mrs. McLaughlin explained how Board and Commission Members are contacted well in advance of their expiration date to ascertain their intentions. Council concurred to reappoint Mrs. Heintz for another term on said Board.

Council concurred that Mrs. Lake represent the City of Centerville at the Meeting scheduled to consider the 1976 Budget for the Hospital Planning Council. She suggested requesting an overall view of how this Board is formed from HEW. She also believes that medical services must be planned for in the future, she sees a need for facilities to the east and to the west of Centerville instead of just one facility.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned.
