Unification of the City of Centerville and Washington Township was discussed. Alternatives were reviewed for placing the question to the electors in June, November or June of 1977. Council concurred with November 1976 election.

Council concurred that a fact finding Committee be appointed, composed of Washington Township residents only, to outline advantages and disadvantages in the incorporation of the total Township. This Committee to submit their report by July 7, 1976. Mayor Green suggested that Don Wright, Editor of the Kettering-Oakwood Times, be the non-voting Moderator for the Committee.

Council concurred that good welfare sessions should be held periodically with the City Manager.

Mayor Green suggested that Council Members submit to the Clerk of Council items which they would like discussed in a Council Work Session.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned.
