The Agreement between the City of Centerville and the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County for the disposal of solid waste was discussed by Council. The Agreement now reflects suggestions made at an earlier date by Council. This item will be on the agenda for the April 5, 1976 Council Meeting; alternatives will be outlined by Mr. Kenning.

Mr. Kenning explained his Community Lighting Program, a five phase plan to improve lighting on Main Street and Franklin Street, in the AP District and at major intersections. The proposal would cost approximately \$23,000.00 per year. Phase Number 1 is proposed for 1976: improved lighting in the AP District. As recommended by Mr. Sweetman, Mr. Kenning will revise his plan to improve lighting on Main Street in the AP District, balance of the funds to be expanded on major critical intersections, lighting will not be less than 21,000 lumens in any case: this will be accomplished in 1976.


Mr. Kenning informed Council that the Cable TV Council has asked for three names to be nominated for the Board of Trustees from each Municipality. One person will be selected for the Board, the other two used for Committees. Mr. Kenning submitted two names: John Levermann and Ken Carper; he asked for other suggestions prior to Monday, April 5, 1976 Council Meeting. The tentative budget for the regulatory agency was distributed by Mr. Kenning, this may be a consideration for next years City budget. Mr. Sweetman expressed his opposition to any up front costs to the City of Centerville.

Mayor Green advised that the Washington Township Trustees have agreed to appoint a fact finding study committee considering recommendations received from other Governmental bodies. They propose a committee the type encouraged by Council.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned.
