Mr. Dean Brandt, Chairman of the Charter Review Committee, outlined for Council the rationale for various changes proposed to the Centerville Charter. Discussion followed concerning an amendment to Article 4, Section 4.10 c Voting, and Article 11 Primary Elections; pros and cons were discussed. Council concurred that if the amendment to Article 4 goes to the electorate, "planning" should be clarified to only include Planning Commission and Board of Architectural Review.

Mr. McQueeney suggested that controversial issues be separated from other minor changes when amendments are put to the electorate, specifically:

1. Primary Elections.

2. Vote required by Council to override a decision of the Planning Commission.

Mayor Green suggested that the City Manager proceed with the preparation of the necessary legislation to place the minor amendments on the November election ballot.
