Mayor Green summarized the procedure Council is following to review the report submitted by the Washington Township Citizens Committee to Study Annexation. A position paper is being prepared and will be completed in a matter of a few weeks.

Mr. John Koverman, Chairman of the Committee spoke in their behalf. The Committee stands by it's report, they believe that changes must be made to the City Charter before annexation can take place. The Committee encouraged the removal of the question from the November ballot and Council's acceptance of their recommendations.

Mr. Dean Brandt, Chairman of the Charter Review Committee, reviewed activities of the Committee. An invitation was extended to the Study Committee to offer ideas for Charter amendments, but none were received.

Mayor Green read the first sixteen pages of the position paper which Council has approved. Council's report is 50% complete, the City is working with haste to complete the report.

Mrs. Pat Schuch requested that questions concerning their report be submitted in writing to the Citizens Committee for clarification.

The Citizens Committee report was further addressed by Council Members, Committee Members and people in attendance.

Mr. McQueeney reminded the citizens in attendance that Township residents must decide the future of the total Community. The total Community will benefit from annexation, advantages were outlined.
