City Beautiful Commission Applicants Dennis Christen and Douglas Wooley were interviewed by Council. Council concurred that legislation be introduced make said appointments.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Ordinance to authorize personnel investigations and limited dissemination of criminal history information relating to applicants for the Washington Township Fire Department. This has been requested by Fire Chief Randall Staley. Council concurred that this item be withdrawn from the Council Meeting agenda; this should be provided by the Montgomery County Sheriffs Department, the policing agency for Washington Township.

Council discussed a letter received from the Washington Township Board of Trustees offering to the City of Centerville animal control through the service of Mr. Eugene Romer, this additional service will cost the Township \$165.00 per month. Animal control in the City of Centerville by the same Eugene Romer during previous years was discussed. Considering previous experiences, Council concurred to request that the Trustees remit the \$165.00 per month to the City for the City's own animal control.
