Centerville's Local Government Fund allocation for 1977 was discussed by Council. Centerville receives a very small portion when comparing it's needs with other Municipalities in Montgomery County. Mayor Green suggested that this be appealed, references indicate additional revenue when cases were appealed. Mrs. Lake and Mr. Stubbs was concerned with appealing after allocations have been established. Mr. Kenning suggested that a letter be sent to the Budget Commission of Montgomery County to put them on notice that Centerville is dissatisfied with it's allocation for 1977 and will expect to receive more in 1978. City Staff will begin now to lay the ground work for a case next year should allocation again be low.

Mr. Reynolds reviewed changes made to the proposed PUD Ordinance, changes to Sections: 36.02C, 36.05A, 36.10A and 36.17A2. The proposed Ordinance will be placed on the agenda for Council Meeting to be set for Public Hearing.

Council encouraged the City Staff to review pros and cons concerning the future for the City of Centerville. Mr. Kenning will attempt to have a report soon after the first of the year.
